

**NOTICE
FAUQUIER COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
PUBLIC HEARINGS**

The Fauquier County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on the following on **Thursday, May 10, 2012** at **6:30 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as the matters may be heard, in the Warren Green Building Meeting Room, 10 Hotel Street, Warrenton, VA 20186:

1. **SPECIAL EXCEPTION #SPEX12-SC-010 & SPECIAL PERMIT #SPPT12-SC-017 – DONG HO SUH (OWNER) / HANSFORD A. CONNER (APPLICANT) – AARON’S TOWING, LLC** – An application for a Category 23 Special Exception to allow for a fence in the floodplain and a Category 14 Special Permit to allow for a motor vehicle impoundment / towing business with a maximum of ten (10) vehicles. The property is located at 4633 Lee Highway, Scott District (PIN 7906-83-9760-000). (Holly Meade, Staff)
2. **COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AMENDMENT #CPAM-12-XX-001** – A Comprehensive Plan Amendment to Chapter 6 – Service Districts – Bealeton, Opal and Remington Service District Plan, to amend transportation elements of the Bealeton Service District Plan. (Susan Eddy, Staff)
3. **ADDITION: A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE FY 2012 ADOPTED BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$6,000,000** – A public hearing to consider the appropriation of \$6,000,000 for the purpose of debt financing for the new cell and leachate treatment system project at the landfill. The Code of Virginia, 15.2-2507, requires a public hearing when amendments to the budget exceed 1% of total expenditures. The FY 2012 threshold for the public hearing requirement is \$3,529,254 based on the FY 2012 adopted budget, which totals \$352,925,432. (Finance Committee, Sponsor; Ari Sky, Staff)
