Small Farm Incubator Program

The Fauquier Education Farm is pleased to announce our new Small Farm Incubator Program. This is an opportunity for up to 4 new farmers to maintain a plot of their own at the Education Farm. This will include a quarter acre plot, with access to irrigation and a deer fence. This also includes some equipment access and material support, as well as twice monthly one-on-one consultation with the Education Farm Executive Director.

This opportunity is intended to support aspiring new farmers who are ready to launch a farm business but do yet have land and equipment of their own, this is not intended for individuals who want a garden for their personal consumption. Business plans will be submitted with the application and will be reviewed each year before renewing the contract. All new farmers in this program will be required to complete the Northern Piedmont Beginning Farmer Program.
