LONG RANGE PLANNING UPDATES:

In regards to the Mental Health Collaborative, neither Mr. Jack Ledden nor Ms. Katie Heritage was able to make that meeting, so there was nothing to report this time.

The Youth and Family Initiative for Health Community meeting was attended by Ms. Erika Visnevskaja & Mr. Frank Finn. Ms. Visnevskaja advised the team that a pilot program, to address building resilience, had begun at Bradley Elementary for 4th & 5th graders. The program is a collaboration between FCPS, Verdun & CADRE.

MEDICAID COPAYS FOR TDT & IHH

Ms. Visnevskaja reported a local provider had been alerted by a single Medicaid MCO, beginning January 1st, 2019 a \$5.00 copay would be assessed for TDT and IHH services. Ms. Visnevskaja contacted DMAS to explore whether families can switch their Medicaid MCO. Thus far no Fauquier families have been impacted.

JLARC REPORT

Mr. Jack Ledden reported that with the last General Assembly JLARC has done a Foster Care Study to ensure the Health and safety of the children in Foster Care. There was 34 recommendations sent to the General Assembly by the JLARC study. Fauquier County does not fall into the JLARC study because the County follows what JLARC recommends.

FAMILY FIRST PREVENTION SERVICES ACT UPDATE

Mr. Jack Ledden reported that there might be changes happening in the near future. It has been recommended that IV-E funds not cover Congregate Care and Group Homes anymore unless with stern guidelines. They want to have Families with resources for Prevention cases and less Families in Foster Care.
