CSA REPORTS

Placement Report: Ms. Visnevskiaia reported on the placement changes in each category.

Financial Report: Ms. Visnevskiaia presented the report.

STATEWIDE CSA UPDATES

The cost study of Private Day Placements is due to be on the OCS website on October 1, 2019.

All the Day Placements used by Fauquier County have signed their contracts with only the state allowed 2% daily rate increase for FY20.

In the future, CPS prevention services will be eligible for IV-E funding. Ms. Visnevskiaia is working with local vendors to increase the number of providers certified to provide these evidence-based services in our area.

AUDIT UPDATES

Ms. Visnevskaja advised OCS requested an update on our corrective action plan. Draft letter to OCS itemizing actions was reviewed.

OCS will be on site for an audit during FY20. The FY19 files were internally audited.

CPMT members reminded to complete trainings.

FY20 Confidentiality statements were signed by all members present.

LONG RANGE PLANNING UPDATES

Mental Health Collaborative was attended by Mr. Jack Ledden. Mr. Ledden reported the Collaborative was outlining new goals to cover through 2022. Four goals were identified and added to the plan.

The Youth and Family Initiative for Health Community meeting was attended by Ms. Erika Visnevskaja & Mr. Frank Finn. The Pride Survey will be completed online, by grades 6-12 on September 17-19. The Pride Survey will be administered in Fauquier County Public Schools, Highland, and Rappahannock County Schools.

A Youth Community Dialogue is being planned for November to share highlights of survey.

Fauquier County is one of 20 sites in the nation piloting Youth-to-Youth Mental Health First Aid.

Youth for Tomorrow is expanding its Warrenton office. Two new counselors will begin seeing clients October 1. YFT Warrenton has just opened (in last 10 days) an intensive outpatient program to treat adolescent substance use.

It was determined to review CQI once a quarter.

CHAIR TIME

Ms. Katie Heritage reported that the county is working with the CSB to move to their new location by end of the year.
