ADOPTION OF THE SEPTEMBER 2019 MINUTES

CSA REPORTS

Placement Report: Ms. Visnevskaja reported on the placement changes in each category.

Financial Report: Ms. Visnevskaja presented the report and compared Q1 FY20 encumbrances and expenses with Q1 FY19.

STATEWIDE CSA UPDATES

Ms. Visnevskaja presented updates from the most recent statewide Coordinators meeting, including most recent information on Family First implementation and Behavioral Health Redesign. Four therapies will be eligible for reimbursement from IV-E Prevention funds: Multi-Systemic Therapy, Functional Family Therapy, Parent/Child Interaction Therapy and Trauma Focus CBT. Ms. Visnevskaja will reach out to local providers to discuss their plans for implementing these therapies.

Ms. Visnevskaja also advised there are concerns and much discussion across localities struggling to place aggressive youth.

POTENTIAL CHANGES IN FAPT SCHEDULE

The FAPT team is exploring adding a 3 FAPT day per month. At this time the team is discussing adding the 4th Tuesday of the month. This change will be implemented in January.

LONG RANDE PLANNING UPDATES

Mental Health Collaborative will have another meeting on Friday November 15, so there was nothing new to report.

Mr. Frank Finn shared outcomes of the Youth Community Dialogue which included students from all Fauquier middle and high schools, as well as students from Rappahannock County Schools and Highland. Preliminary data from the 2019 PRIDE survey was presented to the students and they were given time to develop plans to use in their schools to make all students aware of these outcomes. The event also included a speaker, Darrell Belome, who provided motivation to the students to implement their plans. The PRIDE Survey should be published by the first of the year.

Erika Visnevskaja discussed several reports generated from the CQI section of the OCS website to demonstrate the positive impact increased SPED Wrap funding had on lowering outplacements. Additionally, the increasing costs of transportation over the last 5 years was discussed.
