DECEMBER 5, 2019**

The meeting was called to order at 2:59PM.

The minutes from the November 6 & 8, 2019 Board meeting were approved as written.

Planning for the March 2020 primary election is on track. Ballots will be ordered to cover 50% of eligible voters.

Old Business:

- Update on planning for no-excuse absentee voting in 2020. Good progress here. The supervisors are aware of the issue. Mr. Wiedenfeld was able to meet with Paul McCulla. We'll watch to see the fiscal impact statement for each of the bills provided on the Legislative Information Service website. Also, whether it is included in Paul McCulla's budget. The Board felt the Depot in Bealeton is not adequate for a voting center.

Registrar's Report:

- State cybersecurity self-assessment as per HB 2178 (Acts 2019 c. 426) - Mr. Ables is four fifths of the way through the online assessment. Next Friday, he will meet with the Fauquier County Information Technology staff to fill in the gaps.
- No word yet on the post-election audit for the November 2019 general election.

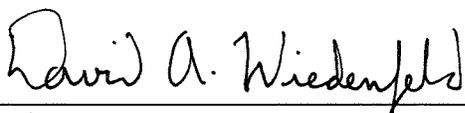
New Business:

- The next meeting will be January 24, 2020 at 3:30PM.

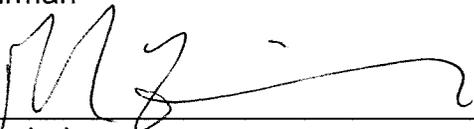
There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 3:36PM.

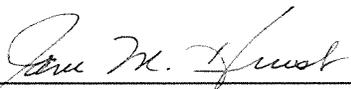
