FAUQUIER COUNTY TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE  
April 27, 2015 E-mail Meeting

Mr. Ed Moore sent an e-mail to the voting members of the Fauquier County Transportation Committee on Monday, April 27, 2015, opening an e-mail meeting to vote on the FY 2016-2021 Interstate Roads and Primary Roads Six-Year Improvement Programs (SYIPs) and the FY 2016-2021 Secondary Roads Six-Year Plan (SSYP).

*The purpose of this meeting is to update the Committee on the proposed revisions to Fauquier County's three Six-Year Plans and vote on these plans.*

*At the Transportation Committee meeting on Wednesday, April 22, 2015, a quorum was not present and therefore the Committee was unable to vote on the recommended changes to the Interstate, Primary, and Secondary Roads Six-Year Plans. These plans must be submitted to VDOT by June 1, 2015. To meet this timeline, the Transportation Committee must vote on the recommended plans to send to the Board of Supervisors for their upcoming meeting on Thursday, May 14, 2015.*

*During the regular meeting, April 22, 2015, the following changes were recommended for the FY 2015-2016 through 2020-2021 Secondary Roads Six-Year Plan (SSYP):*

- ***Add the Safety Improvements at Rogues Road (Rt. 602) and Academic Avenue (Rt. 9956) at Kettle Run High School (Proposed Priority 1).*** *The Fauquier County Board of Supervisors passed a resolution on December 11, 2014 to fund these improvements from the current Rogues Road project (UPC #104300).*
- ***Remove Bridge Replacement and Approaches over Branch of Goose Creek on Ashville Road (Rt. 723) (Existing Priority 6).*** *This project has been completed and can be removed from the FY 2015-2016 through 2020-2021 Secondary Six-Year Plan.*
- ***Add the Safety and Operational Improvements at the Intersection of Shepherdstown Road (Rt. 793) and Broad Run Church Road (Rt. 600) (Proposed Priority 6).*** *At the January 28, 2015 Transportation Committee meeting, the committee recommended adding this project to the Six-Year Plan.*
- ***Remove Moss Hollow Road (Rt. 728) for paving (Existing Priority 13).*** *This road is not a candidate to be paved under the Rural Rustic Program. Following a meeting with residents on April 8, 2015, Supervisor Schwartz recommended that the Transportation Committee remove this project based on their feedback. Attached is a summary of the comments County Staff has received to date regarding their position and reasoning as well as the position of the property owners on Moss Hollow Road.*

*(Note: The attached SSYP resolution indicated additions to the plan in bold text and the omissions from the plan in red text with a strikethrough.)*

*The following changes were recommended for the FY 2015-2016 through 2020-2021 Primary Roads Six-Year Plan (SYIP):*

- ***Add the Intersection Improvements at Vint Hill Road (Rt. 215) and Broad Run Church Road (Rt. 600) (Proposed Priority 4).** At the January 28, 2015 Transportation Committee meeting, the committee recommended adding this project to the Six-Year Plan. It was expressed by the committee that this project is a high priority, therefore, it was*
- ***Add text to the Route 15/29 project to include language protecting the battlefield (Proposed Priority 6).***

*(Note: The attached SSYP resolution indicated additions to the plan in bold text.)*

*No changes were recommended for the FY 2015-2016 through 2020-2021 Interstate Six-Year Plan (SYP). However, the committee did request to receive the background information on the two projects that are currently listed in this plan. Staff will try and locate this information to send to the Committee for review as soon as possible. To date, neither of the two interstate projects have been added to the State's Six-Year Plan for funding so it is recommended that the Committee still vote on this plan, even if you decide that you do not recommend sending any interstate projects for inclusion in the Six-Year Plan, and not wait for the background information.
