

Remote Sites Time Change

As of Monday, November 5th, all remote sites will change to the winter schedule. The remote sites will be open Mondays and Thursdays from 9am to 5pm, except for the Remington Recycling Site, which will be open Mondays from 12pm to 5pm, remaining closed on Thursday. This follows the fall Daylight Saving Time change on Sunday, November 4th, so don't forget to adjust your clocks back one hour on Sunday.

Halloween Costume Recycling

U.S. consumers were predicted to spend \$3.2 billion for Halloween costumes in 2018*, many of which end up in landfills. Halloween costumes are often made with low value materials or non-biodegradable polyester, and decorated with non-fabric items, such as feathers and plastic. This makes costumes harder to recycle, and these materials will not decompose in a landfill. Donate old costumes to schools and theater groups, or re-use them by changing accessories.

Fauquier County Environmental Services offers textile recycling at all collection sites. Bring in clean and dry items for drop-off. Stained or torn clothing is accepted. Purses, belts, and paired shoes in fair condition are accepted as well.
