Mission Statement

Criteria for Selection:

1. All nominees must be of good character and reputation.

3. Nominees eligible for induction should have promoted and validated the values and dignity associated with the Fauquier County Parks & Recreation and Fauquier County.
4. Types of Nominees may include, but are not limited to:
 - Organizations (boards, committees, civic groups)
 - Former Employees (full-time, temps, instructors)
 - Individuals/Citizens (volunteers, donors, citizens, former members of the Board of Supervisors or Parks & Recreation Board)
