## **Pedestrian Struck by Vehicle in New Baltimore Area**

**WARRENTON** - Sheriff's deputies are investigating an early morning crash involving a pedestrian on Broad Run Church Road in the New Baltimore area of Fauquier County. On Monday morning, March 11, 2019, deputies responded to a report of a pedestrian struck by a vehicle at 8:35 a.m. The incident occurred in the 5100 block of Broad Run Church Road near Kelly Road.

Initial investigation determined a trash service truck was collecting refuse on Broad Run Church Road and had stopped at a driveway. A worker exited the truck and attempted to collect refuse on the opposite side of the roadway when he was struck by a 2017 Jeep driven by a 40 year old female from Warrenton. The vehicle was apparently attempting to pass the truck on a double yellow line in a no passing zone.

The victim, a 28 year old male from Manassas, Va., sustained injuries and was flown by helicopter for medical treatment.

The incident remains under investigation, charges are pending.
