Remote Sites Time Change



As of Monday, November 4th, all remote sites will change to the winter schedule. The remote sites will open Monday and Thursday from 9am to 5pm, except for the Remington recycling site, which will open Monday from noon to 5pm, remaining closed on Thursday. This follows the fall Daylight Saving Time change on Sunday, November 3rd, so don't forget to adjust your clocks back one hour on that Sunday.

Loose Needles

Every year in the U.S., between 7 and 8 billion used medical needles (home sharps) are discarded in trash. These discarded needles account for up to 850,000 injuries per year, many of them among solid waste workers. Fauquier County Environmental Services offers safe needle disposal* at all public collection sites, to help prevent injuries caused by loose needles in trash and recycling.

Please do not place any needles in trash or recycling. When bringing needles to a collection site, please do not bring loose needles, but place them in a “home sharps” container or similar sturdy plastic container with lid. You may then give them to any site attendant for disposal.

**This free service is for county residents only, needles cannot be accepted from commercial sources.*

Commercial Rate Increase



As of Tuesday, October 1, 2019, the commercial rate for MSW disposal will increase from \$60.00 per ton, to \$61.00 per ton. This rate change affects MSW fees *only*, all other commercial fees remain the same.
