America Recycles Day



Friday, November 15th is America Recycles Day. Ed E. Earth, the Environmental Services recycling mascot (pictured above), will make an appearance at Bradley Elementary School in Warrenton to celebrate.

In the spirit of the day, we would like to offer a few tips to help County residents recycle the right way:

- Rinse all bottles and cans before recycling, to lower contamination and reduce the risk of insect stings for the public and recycling workers
- Empty recycling from plastic bags and recycle clean, dry bags separately
- Place flattened, clean corrugated cardboard in the cardboard container, not with mixed paper (pizza boxes of any kind are not accepted for recycling due to food waste)

Remote Sites Time Change



As of Monday, November 4th, all remote sites will change to the winter schedule. The remote sites will open Monday and Thursday from 9am to 5pm, except for the Remington Recycling Site, which will open Monday from noon to 5pm. This follows the fall Daylight Saving Time change on Sunday, November 3rd, so don't forget to adjust your clocks back one hour on that Sunday.

Cooking Oil Disposal

Deep frying is a popular way to prepare a Thanksgiving turkey, for many County residents. In the days that follow the holiday, residents often have questions about disposal of cooking oil. Cooking oil is not recyclable with used motor oil, and should not be placed in any used motor oil collection tank. Environmental Services does not currently have an outlet to recycle used cooking oil, and free liquids should not be placed in household trash in large quantities. To properly dispose of used cooking oil, mix it with plain kitty litter or other absorbent material, and then it may be safely placed in the trash.

This price reduction is only available to Fauquier County residents. As always, tires may be brought to the Corral Farm Bulk Recycling area *only*, Monday through Saturday.
