## **SEARCH WARRANT FINDS METHAMPHETAMINE**

**REMINGTON, VA** – A narcotics investigation by the Blue Ridge Narcotics and Gang Taskforce led to the execution of a search warrant at a residence in Remington. The search warrant was the result of an investigation into the distribution of methamphetamine in the area.

On Friday, November 8, 2019, members of the BRNG Task Force and the Fauquier County Sheriff’s Office conducted a search warrant operation at a residence in the 11000 block of James Madison Street in the Town of Remington. During the execution of the search warrant, one suspect jumped from a window and fled on foot. That suspect, identified as Anthony Poole, was captured a short time later with the assistance of the Sheriff’s Office Unmanned Aerial Systems Unit and K-9 Hank.

Four suspects were taken into custody on narcotic related charges:

Anthony Poole, 28, of Remington, is charged with possession of methamphetamine, and a 3<sup>rd</sup> or subsequent offence of distribution of methamphetamine.

Robert Logue, 33, of Remington, is charged with possession of heroin and possession of methamphetamine.

Rebecca Bishop, 39, of Remington, is charged with possession of methamphetamine

Kenneth Macafee, 29, of Remington, is charged with possession of methamphetamine

No bond information was available at the time of this release.

Sheriff Mosier praised the efforts of the Blue Ridge Narcotics and Gang Taskforce for their continued efforts to help combat narcotics distribution in Fauquier County.
