Catlett Compactor Fire



On Friday, January 24th the Catlett residential collection site was temporarily closed at 10:00 am due to a fire in a trash compactor. The Catlett Volunteer Fire Department responded, and quickly put out the flames. The site remained closed for several hours to allow for fire investigation and cleanup, and re-opened by 1:00 pm.

The fire was determined to have been started by wood ashes igniting other trash in the hopper of the compactor. As a reminder, Environmental Services asks residents to please follow basic safety guidelines when disposing of ashes. Any ashes and coals should be placed in a metal container with lid, thoroughly wet down with water, and allowed to cool for at least several days. When they are wet and cold to the touch, they may be disposed of with household trash. Never place dry ashes in trash containers, even if you believe them to be cool.
