SUSPECTS CHARGED IN SUMERDUCK ROBBERY

SUMERDUCK – Deputies are investigating a robbery in Sumerduck after the victim and suspect agreed to the sale of a pair of shoes. Two individuals have been charged with robbery and other offenses after deputies executed a search warrant at a residence in the 5200 block of Sumerduck Road.

On Thursday evening, February 13, 2020, deputies met the juvenile victim and his father at the Sumerduck Post Office at 7:14 p.m. The victim reported he was selling a pair of Space Jams tennis shoes and a friend from school agreed to purchase them. After negotiating the sale of the shoes the victim went to the suspect’s residence.

Once at the residence, the victim was led to the basement by the friend. While in the basement the victim was approached by another male wearing a black hoodie and red bandana over his face. The victim was threatened and the shoes were taken. The victim was eventually able to leave the residence and met with his father.

Deputies executed a search warrant at the residence and recovered the shoes and other items. Two suspects were taken into custody. A juvenile, 16, of Sumerduck was charged with robbery and conspiracy to commit robbery. A juvenile detention order was granted and the juvenile is being held in a regional juvenile detention center.

Deputies also charged an adult, Keshawn James Brittain, 19, of Sumerduck, with robbery, conspiracy to commit robbery, abduction and contributing to the delinquency of a minor. Brittain was held on a \$2500.00 secured bond at the Fauquier County Adult Detention Center.
