Site Safety Tips



Whether visiting the Corral Farm Transfer Station, Bulk Recycling, Public Collection Site or one of the County's six remote Collection Sites, please remember the following tips to keep everyone healthy and safe:

- Keep pets and small children inside vehicles at all times.
- Turn off vehicle engines while unloading.
- Do not stand on edges of containers or compactors while unloading.
- Pay close attention to traffic, especially on very busy days.
- Wear closed-toe shoes when outside your vehicle, to prevent injury.
- Bring very large or heavy items to Corral Farm, for assistance with unloading.

Remote Sites Time Change



As of Monday, March 9th, all remote sites will change to the summer schedule. The remote sites will open Monday and Thursday from 11:00 am to 7:00 pm, except for the Remington Recycling Site, which will open Monday from 2:00 pm to 7:00 pm, remaining closed on Thursday. This follows the spring Daylight Saving Time change on Sunday, March 8th, so don't forget to adjust your clocks forward one hour on Sunday.

Used Motor Oil Recycling

Fauquier County Environmental Services recycles used motor oil at no cost to *County residents only*. Businesses and farms may not recycle used oil through the residential program. Oil collection tanks are located at the Corral Farm Facility, and at the Marshall, Morrisville and Catlett Remote Sites.

Oil is accepted in residential quantities, *limited to 15 gallons per day in containers no larger than 5 gallons each*. Please do not mix your oil with water or other fluids. Contaminated oil will not be accepted for recycling, but must be disposed of through our residential Household Hazardous Waste program.

Used cooking oil is not accepted for recycling, but may be disposed of by mixing with kitty litter or other absorbent material, and placing the material in household trash.

Half Price Tire Event



Wednesday, April 1st begins the County's semi-annual half price tire event. For the entire month of April, all passenger tires will be charged at \$1.50 per tire, rather than the usual \$3.00 per tire rate. This price reduction is only available to Fauquier County residents. As always, tires may be brought to the Corral Farm Site only, Monday through Saturday.



Recycling Yard Equipment

Spring is when many County residents begin to think ahead for summer, and replace some yard equipment. Old yard equipment can be recycled as scrap metal, if properly prepared. Please remove all fluids from tanks, and remove any batteries before placing yard equipment in a scrap metal container. Batteries and used oil may be brought to the Corral Farm Site at any time for safe recycling. Gas, fuel mix or other fluids should be brought to Corral Farm on our HHW collection days only, the first and third Saturday of every month.
