**FY 2021 Proposed Budget and Tax Year 2020 Tax Rates Public Hearing Location
Change – Warrenton Community Center**

Warrenton, Virginia – Governor Northam today ordered all K-12 schools in Virginia to close for a minimum of two weeks related to the novel coronavirus, or COVID-19. As such, the advertised public hearing on the FY 2021 proposed budget, to be held on March 19, 2020 at 7:00pm, will be moved from the scheduled Fauquier High School location to the Warrenton Community Center, 430 East Shirley Avenue, Warrenton, Virginia.

The budget public hearing, as well as all budget work session, are live streamed on the County's website as well as the public access television station.
