Fauquier County Sheriff's Deputy Stops Vehicle for Dangerous, Excessive Speeding.

On the late afternoon of Sunday July 26, 2020, D.F.C. Andrew Stribling was operating stationary radar when he observed a 2019 Dodge Challenger traveling eastbound enter his radar at 141 mph in a 55 mph zone. After the vehicle entered the radar, D.F.C. Andrew Stribling attempted to activate his emergency equipment. As the vehicle passed D.F.C. Andrew Stribling, the vehicle came to a stop on the right shoulder of the roadway. D.F.C. Andrew Stribling made contact with the driver a Mr. Mason Fitzpatrick 22 year old male from Beaverton, MI. Apologetic for his actions, Mr. Fitzpatrick admitted to his extreme speed. Mr. Fitzpatrick was issued a Virginia Uniform Summons for Reckless Driving Speeding 20 MPH (plus) over posted speed limit and released from the scene without incident. The incident occurred in the 8000 block of Rt. 211 (Lee Highway).
