"Pro-Active" Patrol leads to two Arrest and multiple charges

The Plains, VA – On Thursday, August 13, 2020 at approximately 4:42 p.m., a Fauquier County deputy responded to a suspicious incident at the 4500 blk Old Tavern Rd. The deputy received a report of a small sports utility vehicle occupied by two females driving toward U.S. Rt. 17 and the individuals appeared to be impaired. The Fauquier Sheriff's deputy located the vehicle which was parked on the shoulder of Old Tavern Rd.

Upon arrival, the deputy made contact with the occupants of the vehicle. The Fauquier Sheriff's deputy during his investigation identified the two female subjects as Brittany Baldwin, 23, of Bealeton, VA, and Tishanna McColgan, 27, of Manassas, VA. Ms. McColgan reported to the deputy that their vehicle had ran out of gas and asked to use a phone. While Ms. McColgan was using the phone, the deputy proceeded to continue his investigation. The Fauquier Sheriff's deputy had our communication division check the vehicle registration. The deputy was notified that the 2006 Subaru Forester was entered as stolen out of Prince William County, VA.

The two female subjects could not present a driver's license but was able to provide their social security cards. The Fauquier Sheriff's deputy conducted a license check on both individuals. After a license and wanted check of the two females was conducted, Ms. Baldwin came back wanted out of Culpeper Police Department for Fail to Appear in Culpeper General District Court.

The sheriff's deputy proactively furthered his investigation regarding the stolen vehicle. During the deputy's roadside interview the two females were asked about the stolen vehicle and their stories were different and was not consistent.

Tishanna McColgan, of Manassas, was charged with a felony warrant for possession of a stolen vehicle and misdemeanor warrant for driving revoked DUI related. Tishanna McColgan at the time of the arrest was being held at the Fauquier County Adult Detention Center on a secure bond.

Brittany Baldwin, of Bealeton, was charged with a felony warrant for possession of a stolen vehicle and drunk in public. Brittany Baldwin at the time of the arrest was being held at the Fauquier County Adult Detention Center on an unsecured bond.
