DUSE CONVICTIONS SUSTAINED IN HIGHER COURTS

WARRENTON, Virginia – October 9, 2020. The Court of Appeals of Virginia and the Supreme Court of Virginia have denied all petitions filed by Bernard Clark Duse, Jr. and counsel thereby finally sustaining Duse's conviction in the murder of Rex Olsen in 2017.

Duse was convicted of First Degree Murder and Use of a Firearm in the Commission of Murder in the homicide of Rex Olsen, 64, and received a combined sentence of life and three years in prison.

On July 26, 2017, Warrenton Town Police Department units responded to a CVS Pharmacy at 510 Blackwell Road in the Town of Warrenton, VA for a suspicious incident. Once on scene, law enforcement found a male identified as Rex Olsen, deceased, at the rear of the store near a trash dumpster.

Mr. Olsen was the store manager at the time of his death, and he was a supervisor of Mr. Duse.
