How to Prepare for Recycling:

These materials are "ACCEPTABLE" in the used antifreeze tank:

- Ethylene glycol based antifreeze
- Glycol based coolants from chillers/HVAC systems
- Propylene glycol based antifreeze
- Ethylene glycol based de-icers/antifreeze

These materials are "NOT ACCEPTED" in the used antifreeze tank:

| Radiator flush water | Used oil |
| Flammable liquids | Chlorinated solvents |
| Transformer oil | Metal working fluids |
| Refrigeration oil | Brake cleaner |
| Parts cleaning solvent | Carburetor cleaner |
| "Non-toxic" antifreeze | Freon |
| Engine cleaner | Brake fluid |
| Fiberglass resin | Ice melters |
| Gasoline | Naphtha |
| Pain/paint thinner | Hazardous waste |



Why Recycle?

Similar to motor oil, antifreeze never wears out, it just gets dirty. When filtered, it can be reused.
