3. New Business
 - Archaeology Month public workshop (October)
Ms. Wheatcraft proposed to host a public archaeology workshop to celebrate Virginia Archaeology Month and bring attention to Fauquier County's remarkable archaeological sites and the different methods of protecting them. The workshop would be held on October 11 & 12 and would consist of an evening lecture presented by Mike Barber, the State Archaeologist, at the AAHA museum theater in The Plains, followed by a day of hands-on archaeology for the public at the Creel House property on Bull Run Mountain. The Virginia Outdoors Foundation, the property owner, would help coordinate the event. The ARB discussed the proposed workshop and decided that the ARB would co-host the event. Event planning will continue during the August, September, & October ARB meetings.
