
HOW DID YOU CELEBRATE EARTH DAY?

WINNERS OF TREX PLASTIC FILM RECYCLING CHALLENGE

Fauquier County Public Schools were once again invited to participate in the annual plastic film recycling challenge sponsored by TREX, in Winchester, VA. Fifteen schools in Fauquier County participated in the challenge this year and over 550 schools participated nationwide. Fauquier County schools collected a combined total of 8,916 pounds of plastic bags and consumer film. What an amazing number! Congratulations to H.M. Pearson for winning the Fauquier County collection with 4,335 pounds of plastic bags collected and 10.975 pounds per student! H.M. Pearson will receive a free bench from Trex!

Fauquier County had tough competition. Pearson is ranked 2nd among all 550 schools for most pounds collected and 3rd for most pounds per student. Way to go Fauquier County!
