1. *Approval of March 28, 2012 Committee Meeting Minutes*

ACTION:

On motion made by Adrienne Garreau and seconded by Pete Eltringham, it was moved to postpone action until the next meeting, after recommended changes have been reviewed.

2. *Route 17 in Bealeton*

Mrs. Eddy and the committee members reviewed the check list of Julie Wickham's suggested improvements versus what is listed in the proposed Comprehensive Plan Amendment, the Draft Route 28 Study and the remaining suggestions.

ACTION:

The Committee members requested Staff prepare a list of school related suggestions for the School Transportation Division, ask VDOT to look into current speed data for the following areas: Route 28 west of Route 17 to Route 29 and Route 17 south of Route 28 from Schoolhouse Road to south of Marsh Run, and ask Parks and Recreation to look into adding a barrier along the soccer fields to prevent crossing Route 28.

3. *Super NoVa Vision Plan*

Mrs. Eddy attended the April Super NoVa Vision Plan meeting and stated it was still centered on input of thoughts and ideas. The upcoming meeting will be on May 22nd in Front Royal.

4. *Citizens' Time*

Penny Reed expressed her concerns regarding the speed study performed on Old Waterloo Road. She was skeptical that during the 24 hour period only one bus was recorded, even though Fresta Valley and Fauquier High School are nearby.

Bob Leonard supported her concerns and added that the truck count of 1 seemed low in comparison to what he has counted on that road in a shorter period of time. He would like clarification of the truck classification VDOT uses and definitions of the codes cited in the study.

Ms. Garreau commented that it would be helpful to have Dave Cubbage, with VDOT, interpret the report when he attends the next meeting. Mrs. Eddy added that VDOT should be aware the study does not reflect what the citizens see daily.

Mr. Eltringham suggested the citizens put together a factual list of what they witness on this road and have it ready to discuss when VDOT attends.

5. *Other Items*

Mrs. Eddy stated the school transportation division has submitted the request to VDOT requesting a school bus stop sign on Weaversville Road.

Mrs. Eddy reported that Dan Painter, with VDOT, confirmed that Route 17's CoSS designation does end at Route 66 according to the minutes of the CTB.

Mr. Tedeschi asked if the committee could get a copy of the newest version of NTHB's Broadview Avenue Study in the Town of Warrenton. Mrs. Eddy agreed to get a copy.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:05 p.m.
