1. *Approval of October 27, 2010 Committee Meeting Minutes*

ACTION:

On motion made by Larry Mason and seconded by Holder Trumbo, it was moved to approve the October 27, 2010 Committee meeting minutes. The motion carried unanimously.

2. *Update on Brookside Parkway – Rick Carr*

Mr. Carr reviewed the details of the Brookside Parkway link improvement within the limits of Vint Hill, including the application to participate in the VDOT Revenue Sharing Program.

3. *Citizens' Time*

No citizens spoke at this time.

4. *Other Items*

Mr. Eltringham inquired about the status of the site visit to drive Shepherdstown Road. Mr. Trumbo replied that he and Dave Cubbage are coordinating and it will be scheduled in the near future.

Mr. Eltringham asked the committee to review the first draft of the Transportation Committee request form he worked on with county staff. Mrs. Eddy distributed the form and asked that the committee members review and finalize at the next meeting on January 26, 2011. This form will assist with citizen requests directed by the VDOT Warrenton Residency to Susan Eddy.

Mrs. Eddy updated the committee regarding the Moreland Road citizen request. She spoke with Cheryl Fisher, Director of School Division Transportation, who confirmed that this road is currently on the bus route. Moreland Road is listed as one of the roads to be evaluated at a later date. The committee members agreed to wait to take action in having VDOT perform a study at this time and Mrs. Eddy will contact Mr. Dronsick with an update.

Mrs. Eddy updated the committee regarding the Sumerduck Road citizen request. She received an email from Diane Selby reporting another accident in front of her house. Mr. Trumbo responded that the committee cannot make a request to VDOT if there is no data to create the need for changes along that section of Sumerduck Road - all accidents must be reported.

Ms. Garreau requested that VDOT share the data from the comprehensive 10 year traffic count study performed during 2010 once available. Mr. Trumbo added that he would also like to know of any problem points, significant pattern changes or other information VDOT has learned from this study.

Mr. Mason presented the Resolution of Appreciation to Sam Poles which was approved by the Transportation Committee.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:09 p.m.
