1. *Approval of May 30, 2007 Committee Meeting Minutes*

Ms. Meade will contact VDOT regarding the status of the road and solutions.

Mr. Smith introduced Ms. Porter-Johnson. She is a Planner for Fauquier County Community Development – Planning Office. Her Master’s Degree is in Transportation Policy, Operations, and Logistics.
