## Recycling Quick Reference



### Cardboard

Flatten and remove packing materials



### Plastics #1, #2 & #5

Rinse and place loose in Plastic & Cans Container



### Aluminum & Steel Cans

Rinse and place loose in Plastic & Cans Container



### Glass Jars & Bottles

Rinse and remove lids. Recycle lids in small metal.



### Mixed Paper

Place in Mixed Paper container - loose no bags. See attendant for book recycling.



### Plastic Bags

Place in plastic bags container.



### Textiles

Must be dry. Pair shoes together.

## Prepare Your Recyclables

### Mixed Paper

Place paper items such as office paper, newspaper, flattened packaged food boxes, magazines and junk mail in the mixed paper container. No plastic bags, strapping etc. No pizza boxes.

### Corrugated Cardboard

Ribbed cardboard should be flattened and all packing materials removed. No plastic or string ties.

### Glass

Rinse bottles and other glass food containers. Metal lids and rings can be recycled with small metal.

### Plastic

Rinse out bottles and jars and replace lids. We take #1, #2 and #5 plastics. Plastics are commingled with aluminum and steel cans. Do not place recycling in plastic bags - place in the container loose.

### Textiles & Leather Goods

Clean dry clothes, drapes, blankets, paired shoes, belts, purses, towels, sheets, etc. Clothing may be ripped or stained. No pillows or comforters.

### Aluminum & Metal

Rinse cans and other food containers. Place in plastic and cans container.

### Scrap Metal

For lawnmowers and items with engines remove battery and drain oil, antifreeze and fuel.

### Household Batteries

Cover battery terminals with clear tape. Place button batteries between two pieces of clear tape.

## Collection Programs at Corral Farm

### Hazardous Household Waste (HHW)

Accepted items include battery acid, cleaning products, flammable caulks/adhesives, garden chemicals, gasoline, insect sprays, mineral spirits, paints, pet chemicals, rodent control products, etc.

Every 1st and 3rd Saturday of the month: 7am - 3pm

**RESIDENTS ONLY** - No farms or businesses

Quantities limited to 40 lbs. solid or 15 gallons liquid per day in containers no larger than 5 gallons.

### Sharps (Needle) Collection

**FOR RESIDENTS ONLY** - To protect staff from needle stick injuries, Fauquier County provides sharps disposal at residential collection sites. To properly dispose of needles place in a heavy plastic container, such as a laundry detergent bottle, secure lid with duct tape and label "HOME SHARPS". Each site has a designated collection area for sharps. Please see site attendant for assistance.

### Second Generation

The Corral Farm site offers a reuse program called "Second Generation". This program allows residents to donate gently used items - such as furniture, bicycles, toys and infant supplies - which are then provided to nonprofit organizations to help families in need. This program does not accept appliances, electronics, mattresses or bedding, tires, food, clothing, lawn equipment, paint or hazardous materials.

### Electronics Recycling

Electronics can be recycled at Corral Farm Monday thru Saturday. Some electronics have disposal fees. Please see fee schedule for details.

## Recycling Bin Rentals



We offer free recycling bins for events of all sizes, including festivals, neighborhood gatherings, sporting events and more!

Each recycling bin features a collapsible metal frame and a snap on lid designed for recycling collection. Clear recycling bags are provided at no cost.

Bins may be picked up and returned by appointment.
