Lance Davenport called meeting to order at 6:03 pm. Motion to approve the minutes from prior meeting made by Stribling, seconded by Frantz, all members were in favor of the approval.

Public Time was opened and closed with no speakers.

Lance Davenport introduced new Board Members Lt. Kamerer (WPD) and Captain Parsons (FCSO).

Lance asked the Board members if there was anything they had to for him. No speakers.

Lance Davenport covered the following items:

- 7/1/25 stickers are all paid up, make sure they are on trucks he will be relaying and will tell them to turn away. If you need anything checked let him know. Aaron advised he has 8-10 more and needs timeframe set up.

- ID's most know the drivers, if driver is asked for Tow ID don't take offense there are new faces on the road.

- Zoning issues should be back in compliance and will check in two weeks or so with zoning

- 30-minute response times light 45 for heavy duty, if you are 5 to 10 minutes behind, let them know

- if have issues with individual companies Lance will take care of unless it needs to go to the board level
- Random storage lot and receipt checks
- Rotation problems: not tow company/deputies fault, there are new people in Communications, Sgt. Frantz advised no problems recently
- Heavy Duty issues owners request dispatch not relaying and talked to deputies
- Aaron questioned 30 minutes eta Lance said if not a traffic hazard they are allowing
- AAA tows- Aaron stated complaints from AAA guys
- issues with other companies Lance will look into, let process work
- Contract towing moving forward, reaching out to neighboring jurisdictions in a few months, will be handled through procurement, will talk to WPD/State Police to see if they want to continue possible piggyback MOU
 - Stribling questioned procurement handle complaints, tow board go away/ordinance repealed
 - Michael Waggy- Prince William still has tow board
 - Matt Hodge- representation from towing
 - Jusitn Foster- Loudon no tow board
 - Lance advised it is ultimately up to county supervisors; it goes to procurement the county attorney have to sign off Sheriff's goal is to be in place by 7/1 suggestions ordinances change in their hands.

Suggestions from last year for ordinance changes and vacant board spot have been sent to Board of Supervisors and County Attorney.

Aaron requested to have more information from the deputies regarding calls, so they know what is needed prior to getting there.

Parsons relayed Professional Standards question on approval of meeting minutes. Per FOIA training is a draft until approved.

Lance advised there was a FOIA request for meeting minutes that were not approved yet in which meeting draft was provided.

Aaron Conner motioned to close meeting.

Lance asked if they wanted to schedule another meeting, Board decided 11/5/25 at 6:00 p.m.

Lance advised changes in anti-masking statue if have CDL.
